## Understanding parts of speech

### NOUNS

A noun is the name of a person, place, thing or idea.

#### EXAMPLES



David, book, New York, dog, school, car, Ferrari.

### PRONOUNS

A pronoun replaces a noun in a sentence.

#### EXAMPLES



I, me, mine, myself, she, he, her, his, we, ourselves.

### VERBS

A verb is a word or group of words that express an action or a state.

#### EXAMPLES



Run, jump, think, imagine, eat, drive, complete.

### ADJECTIVES

An adjective describes a noun or pronoun.

#### EXAMPLES



Big, pretty, expensive, red, round, sharp, loud, quick.

### ARTICLES

There are only three articles: *the*, *a* and *an*. These words define a noun as specific or unspecific.

#### EXAMPLES



Please watch *a* film.  
Please watch *the* film.

### ADVERBS

An adverb is a word that describes or gives more information about a verb, adjective or even the entire sentence.

#### EXAMPLES



I'll *quickly* run to the shop before *safely* driving home.

### PREPOSITIONS

A preposition is used before a noun or pronoun to connect it to another word in a sentence.

#### EXAMPLES



On, in, at, by, under, above, beside, to, out, from, for.

### CONJUNCTIONS

A conjunction joins words or phrases in a sentence.

#### EXAMPLES



And, or, but, because, so, although, yet, now.

### INTERJECTIONS

An interjection is a short sound, word or phrase used to express the speaker's emotion.

#### EXAMPLES



Oh! Look out! Ouch! Hey! Wow! Ah! Oh dear!
