

QUOTATION MARKS

Use quotes to search for a set of words like an extract from a book or song lyrics.

TILDE

Get results that include synonyms by placing the ~ sign immediately in front of your search term.





TIME [PLACE]

To see what time it is anywhere in the world, type the word <u>time</u> followed by a town or city.



Exclude a word from your search results by placing a minus sign (-) directly before your query.



SITE:[INSERT URL]

Search a specific website by using the term <u>site</u>: followed by the URL.



RELATED:[INSERT URL]

Use the <u>related</u>: query to find websites that contain similar content.




CALCULATOR

Enter any maths equation into the search box and Google will calculate your answer.



PUNCTUATION

When searching, don't include pur or special characters as Google d

CONVERSIONS

Convert any measurement by typing in the number and the unit. E.g. <u>4 miles in km</u>.



FILETYPES

Search for specific types of files, such as PDFs or DOCs by adding filetype: and the file abbreviation.



LOCATIONS

Add a town, city or area code to your search query and Google will find nearby results.



DEFINITIONS

Put <u>define</u>: in front of any word to get its definition.



WEATHER

To find out the weather in any location, just search weather followed by a city or town.



FUN VISUALS

Make the Google search page do a 360° turn by typing do a barrel roll or tilt the page by searching askew.



SUNRISE / SUNSET

Type <u>sunrise</u> or <u>sunset</u> followed by a location, to find out when the sun rises or sets.
